## **Guidance on How to Apply**

The Apply tab on the course webpage will lead you to UCD's Direct Applications page.



Scroll down this page and use the Apply to UCD tab.



When you use that Apply tab you will go to a Course Search page. Then choose either the box for Irish/UK/EU student or the box for International/Non-EU student.

Then scroll down to the Keyword box to find your course – enter the word Reporting in the keyword box and then scroll down to find your course. Choose one.
